The Building Safety Act (the 'Act') has recently introduced secondary legislation which will have a significant impact on a large number of construction projects in England and Wales.

In particular, it introduces a new duty holder regime which applies to all projects to which Building Regulations apply and introduces a new gateway system, certification requirements and other processes for work in relation to Higher Risk Buildings.

These new complex regimes apply from 1 October 2023 and currently there is very limited industry guidance in relation to the approach to take and no standard form contracts have been updated to reflect these regimes.
